The Society annually offers a prize of

\$400

for an essay by an undergraduate student at an Australian university
on any aspect of Classical Studies: the languages, history, thought and
archaeology of the Ancient World.

Up to two “Runner-Up” Prizes of \$100 each may also be awarded.

The essay may be a revised version of an essay, tutorial paper, or seminar paper written by a student enrolled in a first, second, or third year course. The length should be between 2,000 and 3,000 words.

Essays must be submitted to your University ASCS representative
one week before the closing date (that is, 21st November):
